On Monday, August 3, 2009 at 09:00, the Scott County Sheriff's Office will hold a Swearing In Ceremony at the Sheriff's Office 2nd Floor Conference Room in the Scott County Courthouse. Due to the retirement/resignation of deputies, Nathan Comer has been hired as the second of three deputy sheriffs to Scott County.

Nathan Comer will receive his Associates degree from Scott Community College in Criminal Justice at the end of this summer, and graduated from Central High School, De Witt, Iowa. Mr. Comer received the Eagle Scout Award and enjoys football, baseball, track and paintball. Nathan's parents reside in De Witt, IA, where Nathan grew up and was the oldest of three children. On Friday, July 24th, 2009, the Sheriff's Office held a swearing in ceremony for Deputy Sean Thompson.
